

Quick Reference Ordinances:

Animal Complaints (Sec. 14):

Fecal Material (14-16): All persons owning or harboring any animal shall maintain the premises on which the animal has access in a sanitary condition that will not create a health hazard or cause odors that will offend neighbors or person that may pass in the street.

Exterior Maintenance (Sec. 78-2 C 10 a):

Exterior surfaces of all structures shall be protected from water and penetration and against deterioration with a paint covering or other approved material, free of peeling, broken, loose, rotten, crumbling, missing or inadequate finish materials.

Garbage Placement (Sec. 58-120):

Every such person shall limit the time when receptacles are placed on public property or private property beyond the front line of any residence to the period between 6:00 pm the day prior to the regularly scheduled solid waste collection day and 12 hours following the act of collection (see Canton Waste Recycling for pick-up times on the township website or contact them at 734-397-5801).

Grass Height (Sec. 78-2 C 9):

Grass in all landscaped areas shall not be permitted to grow higher than five inches in height.

Inoperable/Unlicensed Vehicles (78-2 C 1, 2):

The storage, accumulation, parking, or keeping of junk, inoperable, or unlicensed vehicles is prohibited except within a completely enclosed building, or those areas possessing a valid junkyard license.

Permits Required (Z 27.08 A 1):

A zoning compliance permit and building permit shall be required prior to the erection, alteration, repair, renovation, demolition or removal of any building or structure and or the excavating, filling or grading of lots. Contact the Canton Building Department to see what and if a permit has to be obtained. Canton Building Department's phone number 734-394-5200.

Recreational Vehicle Parking (Z 4.01 E 1-7):

Temporary Parking: Recreational vehicle parking in the frontline of the home is permitted for a period of not more that 48 hours prior to and 48 hours after the use of the vehicle within a seven day period.

Permits: Two week R.V. permits are available at the Building

Department. Only two R.V. permits are available each year.

Extended Parking: Recreational vehicles may be stored between the frontline and backline of the home provided that they are 10 feet from the property line; or behind the backline of the home provided that they are 3 feet from any property lines.

Signs in the Right-of-Way (Z 6.A-11.11):

Any sign (including **garage sale** and **HOA** signs), that is located in or projects into or over a public right-of-way, publicly dedicated easement, or publicly owned property is prohibited. This excludes traffic or other municipal signs.

Snow Removal (Sec. 62-37):

No person shall permit ice or accumulation of snow to remain on any public sidewalk adjacent to a lot or parcel for a period longer than 72 hours after the ice or snow has formed or fallen. This does not include sidewalks to the rear of a lot or parcel.

Tree Maintenance (Sec. 78-2 C 8):

Trees and shrubs must be kept trimmed so as not to encroach upon any public sidewalk or pathway and a seven foot clearance must be maintained.

Waste Materials (Sec. 78-2 C 3):

The storage, accumulation, keeping, littering, or dumping of waste materials (trash, ashes, dirt, stones, bricks, paper, trees, bottles, cans, etc.) is prohibited. Furthermore, it is unlawful to place any refrigerator out for rubbish collection without first removing the doors.

2011 Covington Square Landscape

- Weeding done on all three Islands and Lilley Rd landscape area
- Edging cut into the three islands and Lilley Rd berm areas
- Mulch put on all three Islands and the two front entrances
- Fertilizing done on all three Islands and Lilley Rd area
- All three islands and both front entrances aerated
- Preen placed on the three islands and Lilley Rd area to prevent weeds from growing
- Tree removed from Lilley Rd Berm
- Trees and bushes trimmed along Lilley Rd and also the bridge area and the school path
- Next year mulch to be placed along all Lilley Rd
- Next year replace 7-8 dead burning bushes along Lilley Rd
- Day Lillies and other shrubs to be cut from the three islands yet this year
- Flowers at the entrances to be removed yet this year
- Street light is out at the Oakland Dr entrance
- Christmas lights????? Who is responsible for this?
- Budget for Landscaping for 2012. Need to increase to replace shrubs, mulch ect.

<u>Covingtonsquare Subdivision – Pond Committee</u>

Annual report:

- This is the first year the association did not hire a contractor.
- All pond maintenance was done by committee members Roger Faber and Larry Ristovski
- We installed the fountain in the spring
- At the beginning of the season we purchased:
 - A bottom rake
 - A floating rake
 - A cutter blade
 - o Enzyme powder
 - Mosquito control pellets
- We raked the bottom of both sides of the pond every month
- The other tools were used to remove floating algae and cut young shoots of cattails.
- After every rake we applied the enzymes and mosquito control

Results:

- No excessive algae growth occurred
- No mosquito issues other than late summer mosquito season
- Ordered a new short cable and repaired the fountain mid-summer
- Fountain removed and stored for the winter

REPORT FOR 2011

- Trash picked up in the woods in the spring
- Cattails cut down and treated at both Truesdale Drain and the Dention Pond area
- High grasses cut down at the western end of the detention pond floodplain
- Low hanging branches over the sidewalks were cut down throughout the subdivision including along the asphalt walkway from Lilley Rd to just past the bridge
- Three homeowners replaced dead trees between the sidewalk and street, three other homeowners had dead trees removed in November
- Letters went out to 22 homeowners this summer requesting them to eliminate weeds in their lawns, driveways or flower gardens
- All mailboxes on Trent Dr, between Lilley Rd and Chase Dr, were moved from the south side of the street to the north side
- Various mailboxes repaired throughout the subdivision
- All crosswalks treated for weeds throughout the summer
- 7 Welcome baskets handed out to new homeowners


