 - b) Sidewalk maintenance reduced, won't need to every year
 - c) Snow removal is high
 - d) Social committee line reduced to \$2500

 - f) Street sealing moved to 2022, and set at \$6500
 - g) Tree replacement reduced to \$600
 - h) Truesdell Drain Wayne Co watershed maintained by county, not sub responsibility

 - (2) Could potentially move to March due date?
